Key Responsibilities

- Lead and develop the parish music ministry in collaboration with the rector and parish council.
- Plan and direct rehearsals and music for our Sunday service and special services (subject to congregational growth, e.g, Advent, Christmas, Holy Week, Easter, weddings, funerals, etc.)
- Partner with musicians in our congregation and wider community to participate in our services.

Qualifications

- A baptized Christian
- Strong theological understanding of worship in the English Prayer Book tradition
- Degree in music (Master's preferred; Bachelor's with relevant experience considered). Training in one or more of voice, choral, organ, piano, or strings
- Experience directing music in an Anglican or similarly traditional liturgical context
